A SHIFT (Setting Up)

Adults earn 6 hours credit for every hour worked. Students earn 3 hours credit for every hour worked.

B SHIFTS (Sorting & Pricing)

Adults earn 6 hours credit for every hour worked. Students earn 3 hours credit for every hour worked.

C SHIFT (Opening Hours)

Adults earn 20 hours credit for every hour worked. Students earn 10 hours credit for every hour worked.

D SHIFT (Running the Sale)

Adults earn 4 hours credit for every hour worked. Students earn 2 hours credit for every hour worked.

8 am - 2 pm

E SHIFT (Take Down)

Adults earn 30 hours credit for every hour worked. Students earn 15 hours credit for every hour worked.
