

Peter Told Cornelius about Jesus (Preschool)-Lesson for May 31st
Scripture Reference: Acts 10

Preschool Life Point: All people need to know about Jesus.

May Memory Verse: Go and tell the good news about Jesus. Mark 16:15

Bible Story:

Cornelius and his family loved God. One day, Cornelius was praying. An angel gave Cornelius a message from God. The angel told Cornelius to find a man named Peter. Cornelius sent some men to find Peter. When the men found Peter, they explained what the angel had told Cornelius. The men said, "Cornelius wants to hear what you have to say."

The next day Peter and the men went to Cornelius' house. Cornelius was there, waiting with his family and friends. Peter told them, "God wants me to tell you that He loves everyone. God wants me to tell you about Jesus." Peter said that Jesus is God's Son. Peter told that Jesus taught people about God. Peter told about the good things Jesus did, like making sick people well.

Cornelius, his family, and friend listened to Peter. They believed everything Peter told them about Jesus. They loved Jesus, too.

Hands on Ideas:

- Have your child draw a house or make a house out of items you have at home. Talk about how God wants all people to know Jesus and we can be the ones to tell the people in our town about Jesus.
- Make suncatchers that look like the world. Think paper plate, tissue paper, and contact paper/plastic wrap/press and seal. Remind your child that God loves everyone in the world and wants them to know about His son, Jesus.
