Scripture Reference: Genesis 26:12-33

Preschool Life Point: People can make good choices.

Bible Study:

Isaac had lots of food. He also had many cows and sheep. He had so many animals and so much food that some people did not like him. One day some people put dirt in Isaac's wells. Isaac could not get water for his animals or his family. So Isaac had to move.

Isaac found a new place to live. Isaac's helpers dug a new well. But the people who lived there said the water belonged to them. Isaac did not want the people and his helpers to argue.

Isaac's helpers dug another well. Again, people said the water belonged to them. So Isaac moved one more time.

Isaac's helpers dug another well. This time the people did not argue with Isaac's helpers. There was plenty of water for everyone.

The king and his helpers came to see Isaac. The king said, "We know God has taken care of you. We don't want to argue anymore. Let's agree that we will be kind to each other."

Isaac was glad that he had chosen to be kind to people who were not kind to him.

Hands on Ideas:

- 1) Make the letter C. You can use pipe cleaners, or anything at home to make the letter C. Choose words that start with the letter C and we can choose to do the right things or the wrong things. Just like in our story Isaac did the right thing.
- 2) Build a well. Use legos or blocks to build a well just as Isaac's helpers dug wells in our story.
